New Business

Keith Schroeder (Chief DLPD) and Steve Nelson (Ramsey County Sheriff) asked the board for range time at the outdoor range. They requested April 23-24 from 1:30 PM to 5:30 PM and have a request to set aside a couple days a month for all law enforcement departments in Ramsey County. Discussion took place on best days and time slots. It was decided that the last Wednesday and Thursday of each month from 1:30 PM to 5:00 PM would work best. They will have to verify with the City that the Landfill will be closed during the timeslots. Mr. Schroeder said he will have a liability form signed because Police training is not typical target shooting. During the discussion Mr. Dannenberg expressed his concern about sharing the range and future construction and the possibility of building a Law Enforcement range. Mr. Schroeder would like to see Norm attend a City Commission meeting to discuss the possibilities.

Mr. Schroeder said the College Peace Officer instructor will be contacting us for range time in September.

Discussion took place on the benefits of having a range flag that would be raised when the range is in use.
