Outdoor Range Rules

1. Check the Inert Landfill to be sure that nobody is there, open the Range Gate to block the road

to the Inert Landfill and put the range in use signs on the road.

2. The ten commandments of gun safety are in effect at all times.

3. The Club is not responsible for loss, theft, or accidents.

4. Guests must be accompanied by the member who is totally responsible for the visitor's behavior.

5. Eye and ear protection is strongly recommended

6. The use of glass or cans or other non-approved targets is strictly prohibited. If you did not bring targets, shoot only at the gongs.

7. The entire firing line must be closed and all actions kept open while anyone is downrange.

8. Shooting is only allowed from the designated firing line.

9. No consumption of alcoholic beverages while the firing line is open.

10. CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF! This includes your targets, paper, trash and any other debris around you.

11. No driving down range when the ground is soft or wet. We cannot leave any ruts.

Indoor Range Rules

1. The ten commandments of gun safety are in effect at all times.

2. The first person at the Range is designated as the Safety Officer, unless other arrangement is made. That person must then personally verify that the range is run safely.

3. The barrier ropes must be in place at the entrance to the range and on each side of the firing line before firing begins.

4. Eye and Ear protection is strongly recommended at all times.

5. Only .22 rimfire ammo or air gun pellets may be used on this range.

6. After firing has terminated:

A. Sweep the floor

C. Put tables & barrier ropes away.

B. Police the brass

D. Shut off the fan & close the vent

E. Turn off all lights & lock the padlocks

F. Lock the outside door
