This is the first time anyone from North Dakota has ever competed at the 4H Nationals in these disciplines. Maria Rosa Nieves, Brandon Alexander and Max Schuh performed very well. Together with a young man from Dickinson competing in the Muzzleloader discipline, they each enjoyed being recognized at the daily awards ceremonies.

Maria, Brandon, Max and Jacob Vaagen also earned the opportunity to compete in the USA Shooting Junior Olympic National Championships at the Olympic Training Center in April of this year. These were great trips, and we hope to be able to repeat the trip to the Junior Olympics again in 2017.

We have already qualified a team of 4 to compete in the discipline of Sporter Air Rifle and have 2 young ladies who will compete with Air Pistols at the 4H Nationals in 2017.
