

SPRING HUNTER SAFETY CLASS

A Hunter's Safety Class will be held beginning January 30, 2012 at Lake Region State College in Devils Lake, ND.

A Hunter's Safety Certificate is required before the State of North Dakota will issue a hunting license to anyone age 12 years or older and born after December 31, 1961. So, any child who will be 12 years old by this fall's hunting season should enroll in the course in order to secure their Hunter Safety Certificate in time for this fall's hunting seasons.

The course will also be of particular interest to those adults who wish to hunt deer in the State of North Dakota this fall and for those who wish to hunt big game outside of the North Dakota where Hunter Safety certification is often required regardless of age.

A student must be 11 years old or more to take the class and secure a Hunter Safety Certificate.

This Hunter Safety course is taught at no charge by volunteers from our local community and is sponsored by the **Lake Region Shooting Sports Association**.
